MASTER INTERNATIONAL MASTER OF INTERIOR-**ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN**

PROGRAMME



The four semesters of this Master's programme with an international profile deepens existing interior design knowledge from the Bachelor's programme and prepares students for an international career in interior design either on a management-level employee or as a freelancer. Place of study in the first, third and fourth semester is the University of Applied Sciences in Stuttgart. Job-related skills are acquired in practical projects, frequently in cooperation with external partners. During the second semester, you will be taking English courses at one of our partner universities. Between the second and third semesters, all IMIAD partners meet annually for an international workshop at one of the university locations.

THESIS The four months of the Master's thesis are devoted exclusively to the independent elaboration of a complex design task. Presentation, defense and critiques are passed in English with professors from the partner universities.

REQUIREMENTS We are expecting an above-average Bachelor's degree in interior design or architecture, good German and English language skills and at least eight weeks of practical experience in the profession.

INTERNATIONAL

During the second semester, you will live and study abroad at one of our partner universities. Depending on the respective location, there is also the possibility to gain further experience on a longer trip or to complete an internship. After the semester abroad, students and professors from all IMIAD partners are getting to know each other during the international workshop.
