



GERMAN COURSES WINTER SEMESTER 2019/20 GENERAL INFORMATION

The German language course consists of **intensive daily language training before the beginning of the semester** (72 teaching hours) and then continues with **weekly language training during the semester** (48 teaching hours).

We strongly recommend **participating in the full-time intensive language courses since the weekly courses are follow-on classes**. However, if you do not have the opportunity to attend the intensive course in September, there still will be the opportunity to join the semester courses in October.

Costs

- German Intensive Course will cost 100 Euros plus course book extra.
- German Semester Courses will cost 50 Euros plus course book extra

On offer are beginner level courses (level A1 and A2) and advanced level courses (B1 and B2 according to the CEFR¹). Additionally, you have to take an **obligatory placement test** in advance in order to allocate you to the appropriate course level.

The German courses take place at Hochschule für Technik (HFT), Academy of Art and Design (ABK) and the University of Music and Performing Arts (HMDK) in Stuttgart. All locations are easily accessible via public transportation.

Course certificates stating grades and the achieved language level are issued after regular attendance and successful completion of course tasks and tests. You will receive 2 to 5 ECTS credits for the successful participation in the German courses.

Language class schedule

1. Placement test for German intensive courses:
 - 2nd September 2019, 10:00 am, Hochschule für Technik, Stuttgart
2. German intensive courses:
 - 3rd September 2019 until 26th September 2019
 - lessons daily from 2:00 until 5:15 pm
3. Placement test for German semester courses:
 - 7th October 2019, 10:00 am, Hochschule für Technik, Stuttgart
4. German semester courses:
 - 9th October 2019 until end of January 2020, courses take place every Wednesday, 12 weeks (time and location depending on your level on German proficiency).
